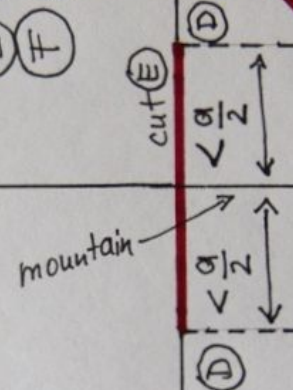


(A) mountain fold

- (A) divide page into quarters (use pencil and erase later)
- (B) draw motives (here: cutang-leel stars) with overlap crossing the middle line of page (will be the valley fold later)
- (C) measure smallest distance to edge of page (measure 1 or measure 2) - the smaller of the two is determining the distance of the long valley folds from middle line let's call it "a".
- (D) pencil in two lines, each being less than half of "a" from middle line
- (E) cut along red lines -
- (F) fold maintains and valleys as indicated
